## This session's objectives:

- To broaden candidates' understanding of the meaning of "Church" through exploring Catholic Social Teaching and how it is lived in personal relationships, the parish community, and the wider world
- To provide a witness of mature Christian life as a model for the candidates to follow

   <u>Red (LS) & Green (RH)</u>: Life & Dignity of the Human Person
   <u>Orange (SM)</u>: Dignity of Work & Rights of Workers
   <u>Pink (KC)</u>: Solidarity
   <u>Black (JKF)</u>: Rights & Responsibilities
   <u>Blue (SP)</u>: Care for God's Creation
   <u>Yellow (IL)</u>: Call to Family, Community & Participation
   <u>Purple (RDM)</u>: Option for the Poor & Vulnerable
  - includes opportunity for reaction to panelists' statements as part of first question
  - each table has (part of) one of the seven components of Catholic Social Teaching
  - use <u>Scripture passage</u> and <u>reflection questions</u> (write answers)
  - <u>create a slogan</u> and use the slogan to <u>create posters</u> that will encourage others to live/act as we are asked to do through this Social Teaching
     should be 1 poster for every 2-3 students so all have a chance to work on one
