A LABOR DAY MESSAGE FROM THE LATE MOST REV. JOHN MANZ

Over Labor Day weekend, I invite you to reflect on the tenets of our faith that proclaim that all workers have sacred worth and, therefore, they deserve dignity and respect. Catholic Social Teaching further instructs us that all workers should have safe work conditions and family-sustaining wages. Yet, as we know, the income gap between the wealthiest and poorest among us continues to grow, resulting in many of our hard-working families living below the poverty line. In response to the growing income inequality around us, Pope Francis recently instructed, "We can no longer wait to solve the structural causes of poverty, to heal our society from a sickness that can only lead to new crises. Markets and financial speculation should not enjoy absolute autonomy. Unless we solve the problems of the poor we shall not resolve the world's problems. We need programs, mechanisms and processes that lead to a better distribution of resources, the creation of jobs and all-around promotion of those who are excluded. Over this holiday weekend I hope you will reflect on how we as Catholics are called upon to end the exploitation of workers. The Archdiocese is proud to be a partner with Arise Chicago, a 28 year-old interfaith organization that boasts Msgr. Jack Egan as one of its co-founders. Arise teaches workers their rights, builds leadership skills, and advocates for public policy changes—all of which transform lives and communities. This weekend, in partnership with the Chicago Federation of Labor (CFL), Arise Chicago has prepared speakers in over 100 services, lifting up the sacred link between work and faith. As a part of our Labor Day reflection, we need to turn away from the idolatry of wealth that can deceive us into believing that we are self-sufficient, and instead embrace the truth that we are all divinely connected to each other. We cannot live in a world without car mechanics, shoe salespersons, teachers, hotel workers, grocery store clerks, nurses, etc. I invite you to honor through your prayers and actions the dignity of workers, especially those who you encounter in your daily interactions. Reflect on how each of us, through our work, contribute our unique God-given gifts to the common good of humanity. Hold in prayer all of those longing for jobs and all of those who labor under poor working conditions. Our interconnectedness in faith and our dependence on each other in life give us a lot to celebrate together! Blessed Labor Day!

UN MENSAJE DEL DÍA DEL TRABAJO DEL DIFUNTO REVERENDÍSIMO JOHN MANZ

A través del fin de semana del Día de Trabajo, les invito a reflexionar en los principios de nuestra fe que proclaman que todo trabajador tiene valor sagrado y, por lo tanto, merecen dignidad y respeto. La Enseñanza Social Católica nos dice que todo trabajador debe tener prácticas seguras en el trabajo y un sueldo justo para poder mantener a su familia. Pero, como nosotros ya sabemos la diferencia de ingresos entre los más ricos y los más pobres sigue creciendo, dejando a muchas de nuestras familias trabajadoras viviendo debajo del umbral de la pobreza. En respuesta a la desigualdad de ingresos que sigue creciendo a nuestro alrededor, el Papa Francisco dijo, "No podemos seguir esperando a resolver las causas estructurales de la pobreza para sanar a nuestra sociedad de una enfermedad que solo nos llevará a una nueva crisis. El mercado financiero y la especulación no debería de disfrutar de autonomía absoluta. Si no resolvemos los problemas de los pobres, no resolveremos los problemas del mundo. Necesitamos programas, mecanismos, y procesos que nos llevarán a una mejor distribución de recursos, crearán empleos y promoción total de todos que están siendo excluidos. Ojalá que, a lo largo de este fin de semana festivo, reflejen en la manera que como nosotros los Católicos somos llamados a terminar la explotación de los trabajadores. La Arquidiócesis está orgullosa de estar asociada con Arise Chicago, una organización interreligiosa que el Msgr. Jack Egan ayudó a fundar hace 28 años. Arise les enseña a los trabajadores sus derechos, desarrolla habilidades de liderazgo, y promueve los cambios en política pública—lo cual cambia vidas y transforma comunidades. Este fin de semana, en asociación con la Federación del Labor en Chicago (CFL), Arise Chicago ha preparado ponentes en más de 100 servicios, uniendo el enlace sagrado entre el trabajo y la fe. Como parte de nuestra reflexión en el día de trabajo, necesitamos darle la espalda a la idolatría que la riqueza nos ciega a creer que somos independientes. Al contrario, debemos adaptarnos a la verdad—que todos estamos conectados por algo divino. No podemos vivir en un mundo sin mecánicos, zapateros, maestros, empleados de hotel, empleados de tiendas de comestibles, enfermeras, etc. Les invito a brindarles honor a través de sus oraciones y acciones a estos trabajadores, especialmente aquellos con los que interactúan en vida cotidiana. Reflejen en cómo cada uno de nosotros, a través de nuestro trabajo contribuimos nuestros regalos otorgados por Dios para el bien de humanidad. Recemos por aquellos que buscan trabajo y aquellos que trabajan en condiciones laborales injustas. ¡Nuestra conexión a través de la fe y dependencia en cada uno de nosotros nos da mucho de que celebrar! ¡Que tengan un bendecido día de trabajo!
