	<p>Queen of Angels Church, set into the Communion Rail in front of the sanctuary, right in front of the tabernacle. These were once a panel from the gates into the sanctuary, back in the days when people had to kneel at the Communion Rail to receive the Eucharist.</p>	<p>Wheat and grapes are made into the bread and wine which become the Eucharist.</p>
	<p>Queen of Angels Church, windows on the west (alley) side of church, above the window showing the marriage of Mary and Joseph.</p>	<p>Angels holding a monstrance and a ciborium, 2 sacred vessels for holding the Eucharist.</p>
	<p>Queen of Angels Church, normally seen on the altar at Mass, when they are used by the priest to give Holy Communion.</p>	<p>Chalice and paten - sacred vessels (or special dishes) for sharing the Eucharist in Holy Communion. This chalice is decorated with an image of the Last Supper, the final meal Jesus ate with his apostles before he was arrested and crucified.</p>
