Queen of Apostles Confirmation Preparation 2023-2024

This session's objectives:

- To make Candidates aware that **reading Scripture** is an important part of being a Catholic Christian: "Ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Christ" St. Jerome
- To build greater skills and confidence with reading, proclaiming & looking up Scripture passages
- To inspire candidates with the **person and ministry of Jesus** as seen in the Gospels

This session's program:

Time Start

- 1. Name-tag & Bible label pick-up; <u>turn in late commitment/retreat forms</u> 10 min 6:45 as enter, candidates are invited to <u>bless selves with holy water</u> (as when entering church) and <u>leave</u> <u>late commitment forms & retreat permission forms in basket on prayer table</u> by holy water chat with catechists at tables or as a class, share journal p. 24
- 2. **Opening Prayer** (Mt 4:18-22 & "Lord, When You Came / Pescador" v. 1&3) 10 min 6:55
- 3. **Reading Scripture (and the Lector Ministry)** (Rachel/Keenan) 10 min 7:05
 review Bible basics (divisions, history, inspired Word, truth vs. fact, genres); how to locate passages
 Jesus as the Word incarnate (w/ St. Jerome quote) "proclaim" vs. "read"
 mini-witness about serving as a Lector share experiences of proclaiming readings at Mass
- 4. "Go Jesus Fish" Matching Game (At Tables/In Groups) 5-10 min 7:15

 Tables/groups test their ability to work together and recall other information about Jesus by using the toss-and-tell balls and/or playing the matching Q&A card game <u>lay out questions as trivia game</u>;

 each table/group gets 2 decks (1 blue, 1 brown) each blue card has a match in the brown deck

 match 12 blue cards with 12 brown cards by determining which questions go with which answers

5. **Breakout Session: Who is Jesus?** (At Tables/In Groups)

30-35 min 7:25

- recommend Track B work in pairs or triadss on all 8 sets of passages
 - important to get 360° view of Jesus by thinking about his different actions
 - see next page for "cheat sheet" of themes among passages for quick reference
- each table/group receives a set of 3 passages relating to a theme of Jesus' life
- reflection questions accompany the passages. Select a scribe to <u>take notes</u> about their answers and a <u>speaker</u> to report on what passages tell us about who Jesus is (<u>final Question</u>)

Speaker from each table/group shares response to final question from sheet

7. The Call to Discipleship (Rachel/Keenan)

10 min 8:10

Based on textbook pages 14-15 and definition of discipleship (see <u>slideshow</u>)

"A disciple... ...hears and studies the ways of the master (Jesus) ...participates in a community of disciples (the Church) ...lives out these ways for the good of the world (life of service)."

Scripture as a source of invitation, where we hear and where we can study "the ways of the master"

Choice to follow – Parable of the Two Sons (Mt 21:28-32) - no/yes w/ mouth & yes/no w/ heart

Pink: parables teaching about the Kingdom of God

The Mustard Seed (Mark 4:30-32)

Orange: what is important to Jesus / Jesus with his friends

Mary & Martha (Luke 10:38-42)
