Kuddos to the team that gathered to say goodbye to our St. Matthias Rectory. While it is hard, of course, to say goodbye, there was also a sense of 'ready for something new' in the air. The sales contract is slated to close in the Spring, later than the 'before Christmas' timeline we were anticipating.

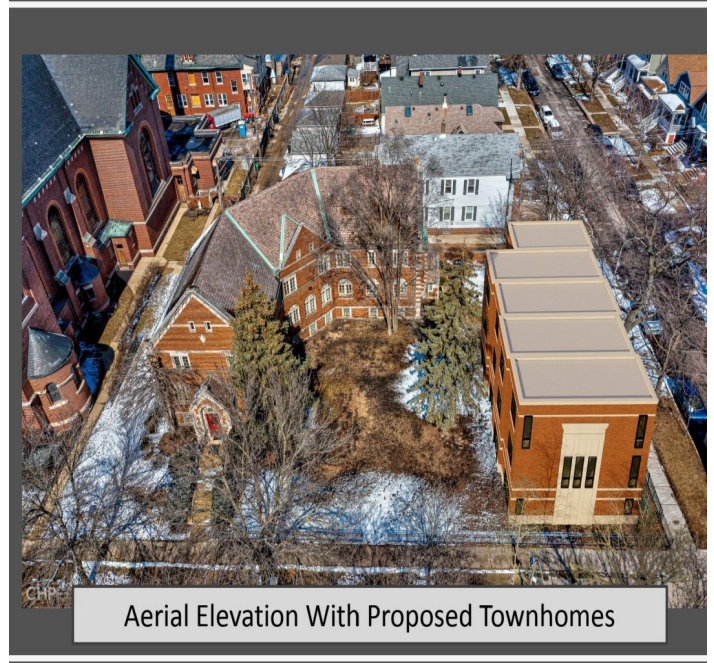
Did you know that the sale of the Rectory had to go to Rome for approval? Because this sale, along with the sale of the east parking lot and Convent, exceed the three million dollar threshold for a cumulative Parish sale, it had to be approved. We received word last week that the sale was approved by Rome, allowing us to close on the parish side. I hope that, for a very long time, this is the last sale for our Parish! Now is time for evangelization and deepening our relationship with Jesus!

On the buyer side, I understand that the rezoning process is complete allowing for twelve apartments in the rectory, and five townhomes along Oakley. I also understand the buyer is currently looking for some variances. I pray that all goes well and the St. Matthias Rectory can find new life. A pic of the buyer's artist's rendering gives us a sense of what is to come.

May God breathe new life into both campuses of our Queen of Apostles Parish.

El contrato de venta está programado para cerrar en la primavera, más tarde de la línea de tiempo 'antes de Navidad' que estábamos anticipando.

¿Sabías que la venta de la Rectoría tenía que ir a Roma para su aprobación? Debido a que esta venta, junto con la venta del estacionamiento del este y el convento, excede el umbral de tres millones de dólares para una venta acumulativa de la parroquia, tuvo que ser aprobada.

La semana pasada recibimos la noticia de que la venta había sido aprobada por Roma, lo que nos permitía cerrar el lado de la parroquia. ¡Espero que, por mucho tiempo, esta sea la última venta para nuestra Parroquia! ¡Ahora es el momento de evangelizar y profundizar nuestra relación con Jesús!

Por el lado del comprador, entiendo que el proceso de rezonificación está completo, lo que permite doce apartamentos en la rectoría y cinco casas adosadas a lo largo de Oakley. También entiendo que el comprador está buscando actualmente algunas variaciones.

Rezo para que todo vaya bien y la Rectoría de San Matías pueda encontrar una nueva vida. Esta foto de las representaciones artísticas del comprador nos da una idea de lo que está por venir.

Que Dios insufla nueva vida a ambos campus de nuestra Parroquia Reina de los Apóstoles.
