Dear Disciples of Jesus,

This week, and next week, the Solemnity of Christ the King, mark the end of our Liturgical year. The beginning of Advent, December 3rd, begins a new Liturgical year. That may sound like Church 'inside baseball' to you, but our readings have a decidedly 'end of time' message inviting us to prepare ourselves well for the end time. Not only the end time when Jesus comes again in glory, but our end time too, when we will see Jesus and His Father face to face in heaven. It is definitely a message that we take to heart and want to heed, especially as it always falls so close to Thanksgiving and Christmas preparation, which could distract us from this message.

Last week at the 5 and 11:00, I invited everyone to prepare ourselves well spiritually in three ways, prayer, reconciliation and trust and belief in the gift of everlasting life. Just a word about all three.

All of us pray, but perhaps as we approach the end of our Liturgical year, we give more time to our personal inventory, more time to our meditation on the mysteries of Jesus, more time in gratitude. To help us, there are copies of the "Word among us" on the back tables for everyone in English and Spanish. These copies, and the two issues following, will be available for your prayer. Perhaps you get yourself a subscription.

Reconciliation is essential to our personal preparation. It is available every Saturday from 9:30 AM till we are done! Further, there will be a communal Advent Reconciliation service on December 19th at 6:30 PM. All of our children at both schools and in Religious Education will be participating this season. Plan on the sacrament this season for yourself.

Finally, belief in everlasting life. I hear lots more talk about reincarnation after we die and that is clearly not what Jesus spoke about. Further, many are not heading the Church's invitation to bury the body or ashes of our loved ones in anticipation of Jesus' rising from the dead. Both these ways of thinking leave me wondering how deeply we hold to the promise of everlasting life in heaven. Either our souls will be with Jesus in heaven or they will not. I believe they will be because Jesus told us so.

Thanks for your deep faith and thanks for your loving preparation in these 'end of year' and end time preparations.

Queridos discípulos de Jesús:

Esta semana, y la próxima, solemnidad de Cristo Rey, marcan el final de nuestro año litúrgico. El inicio del Adviento, el 3 de diciembre, da inicio a un nuevo año litúrgico. Esto podría sonar como si se aplicara solo a las autoridades de la iglesia, pero nuestras lecturas tienen un mensaje decididamente del 'fin de los tiempos' que nos invita a prepararnos bien para el fin de los tiempos. No solo el tiempo del fin, cuando Jesús venga de nuevo en gloria, sino también nuestro tiempo del fin, cuando veremos a Jesús y a Su Padre cara a cara en el cielo. Definitivamente es un mensaje que nos tomamos en serio y queremos escuchar, especialmente porque siempre cae tan cerca del Día de Acción de Gracias y la preparación de Navidad, lo que podría distraernos de este mensaje.

La semana pasada a las Misas de las 5 y las 11:00, invité a todos a prepararnos bien espiritualmente de tres maneras: oración, reconciliación y confianza y creencia en el don de la vida eterna. Solo unas palabras sobre los tres.

Todos rezamos, pero tal vez a medida que nos acercamos al final de nuestro año litúrgico, dedicamos más tiempo a nuestro inventario personal, más tiempo a nuestra meditación sobre los misterios de Jesús, más tiempo a la gratitud. Para ayudarnos, hay copias de la "Palabra entre nosotros" en las mesas traseras para todos en inglés y español. Estas copias, y los dos números siguientes, estarán disponibles para su oración. Tal vez te consigas una suscripción.

La reconciliación es esencial para nuestra preparación personal. ¡Está disponible todos los sábados desde las 9:30 a.m. hasta que terminemos! Además, habrá un servicio comunitario de Reconciliación de Adviento el 19 de diciembre a las 6:30 p.m. Todos nuestros niños en ambas escuelas y en Educación Religiosa participarán esta temporada. Planifique en el sacramento esta temporada por usted mismo.

Finalmente, la creencia en la vida eterna. Escucho hablar mucho más sobre la reencarnación después de morir y claramente no es de eso de lo que habló Jesús. Además, muchos no están encabeizando la invitación de la Iglesia de enterrar el cuerpo o las cenizas de nuestros seres queridos en anticipación de la resurrección de Jesús de entre los muertos. Ambas formas de pensar me dejan preguntándome cuán profundamente nos aferramos a la promesa de la vida eterna en el cielo. O nuestras almas estarán con Jesús en el cielo o no estarán. Yo creo que lo serán porque Jesús nos lo dijo.

Gracias por su profunda fe y gracias por su amorosa preparación en estos preparativos para el 'fin de año' y el fin de los tiempos.
