Dear Friends:

As the Principal of a school, I often feel like I am the "main character" of my school's story. Programming, finances, facility work, and all sorts of daily decisions run past me and need my direction. The main character of a story often feels like he or she has to make sure that everything is going well, and that he or she is in control of everything. There is often the need to make sure everything is perfect.

Daily, I am reminded of how not in control I truly am of things that are outside of my realm. People make choices of their own free will. Loved ones take their last breaths. And the Earth spins on its axis whether I check a task off my list or not. I don't need to be responsible for everything. I don't need to be perfect. And God's word reminds me that I am not and will never be. And that's OK!

Today, especially, when I finally tried out the Hallow app, (yes, I am a few weeks behind!) it was like God was speaking directly to ME! Father Mike's Daily Minute Homily today was called Out of Our Control and the title itself caught my attention because of the pressure that I put on myself to juggle all of the balls in the air at the same time.

In Fr. Mike's reflection I was reminded of how God speaks to us through His Word each day. In this reflection, I was challenged to let go of the idea of the "I'll be happy when..." philosophy that we allow ourselves to be guided by because we have earthly deadlines and deliverables that are required of us. But Father Mike reminded me that God has his own timeline. This reflection also provided me the opportunity to hear that I may not be in charge of all of my circumstances, but that I can be in charge of how I respond to them.

Here are the 3 ways Christians are called to do that:

- 1) Rejoice always
- 2) Pray without ceasing
- 3) In all circumstances, give thanks

Father Mike's reflection pushed me to remember that I can and should do these 3 things all the time. I have to have faith in God and know that He has a plan. And even when it's hard to remain steadfast, for I am called to respond in these ways all the time.

I'm so grateful for the reminder today. And I am encouraged that through the Hallow app, I can allow myself to be open to hearing God's word in a different and unique way, in conjunction with going to Mass. I hope that you will give the Hallow app a try this Lenten season too. Who knows...maybe it will be your opportunity to hear God speak directly to you, like He did with me today!

Queridos amigos:

Como directora de una escuela, a menudo siento que soy el "personaje principal" de la historia de mi escuela. La programación, las finanzas, el trabajo de las instalaciones y todo tipo de decisiones diarias pasan por mí y necesitan mi dirección. El personaje principal de una historia a menudo siente que tiene que asegurarse de que todo va bien, y que él o ella tiene el control de todo. A menudo existe la necesidad de asegurarse de que todo sea perfecto. Diariamente, se me recuerda cómo no estoy en control de las cosas que están fuera de mi reino. La gente toma decisiones por su propia voluntad. Los seres queridos respiran por última vez. Y la Tierra gira sobre su eje tanto si compruebo una tarea fuera de mi lista como si no. No necesito ser responsable de todo. No necesito ser perfecta. Y la palabra de Dios me recuerda que no soy y nunca lo seré. ¡Y eso está bien!

Hoy, especialmente, cuando finalmente probé la aplicación Hallow, (¡sí, estoy unas semanas atrasada!) ¡fue como si Dios me estuviera hablando directamente a MÍ! La homilía del Minuto Diario del Padre Mike de hoy se llamó Fuera de nuestro control y el título en sí me llamó la atención debido a la presión que me puse a mí mismo para hacer malabarismos con todas las pelotas en el aire al mismo tiempo.

En la reflexión del P. Mike recordé cómo Dios nos habla a través de Su Palabra cada día. En esta reflexión, me sentí desafiada a dejar de lado la idea del "seré feliz cuando..." filosofía por la que nos dejamos guiar porque tenemos plazos y entregables terrenales que se nos exigen. Pero el Padre Mike me recordó que Dios tiene su propia línea de tiempo. Esta reflexión también me dio la oportunidad de escuchar que puede que no esté a cargo de todas mis circunstancias, pero que puedo estar a cargo de cómo respondo a ellas. Estas son las

3 formas en que los cristianos están llamados a hacer eso:

- 1) Alégrese siempre
- 2) Oren sin cesar
- 3) En todas las circunstancias, den gracias

La reflexión del Padre Mike me empujó a recordar que puedo y debo hacer estas 3 cosas todo el tiempo. Tengo que tener fe en Dios y saber que Él tiene un plan. E incluso cuando es difícil permanecer firme, porque estoy llamado a responder de esta manera todo el tiempo.

Estoy muy agradecida por el recordatorio de hoy. Y me anima que a través de la aplicación Hallow, puedo permitirme estar abierto a escuchar la palabra de Dios de una manera diferente y única, junto con ir a Misa. Espero que también pruebes la aplicación Hallow en esta temporada de Cuaresma. Quién sabe... tal vez sea tu oportunidad de escuchar a Dios hablarte directamente, ¡como lo hizo conmigo hoy!
