Tangible Signs

Read Genesis 1:1-2. What do you think the wind represents in this passage?

What was the condition of the world before the wind swept across it?

Next read Genesis 7:24-8:1. What is the condition of the world now, before God sent the wind?

Think about what you may already know about the story of Noah and the animals. What change did this wind bring? What could now happen because of that change?

Then read John 3:3-8. What sacrament is Jesus talking about in this passage?

Look again at the final verse in this passage (3:8). What specifically do you think the wind represents in this verse?

Now read Acts 2:1-4. Why does the “strong, driving wind” come to the disciples inside their room?

What is the effect of the wind on the disciples?
