Session 8: Advent (with seasonal Confessions)

Queen of Apostles Confirmation Preparation 2024-2025

This session's objectives:

- To frame Advent as a time of preparation for the three-fold coming of Jesus
- To offer the opportunity for meaningful Confession during the Advent season in the context of lifelong spiritual growth and preparation for celebrating Christmas
- To foster the choosing of a Confirmation Name and the research skills needed to find good information about the chosen saint

This session's program:

- 1. Name-tag pick-up and Icebreaker 10 min 6:45 - students pick up nametags, turn in late forms; check in re: Conf. Name progress - Icebreaker at tables/groups: What are your family's Christmas traditions?
- 2. Opening Prayer for the Advent Season (Rachel/Joe/Anne) 5 min 6:55 Blessing of the Advent wreath & "O Come, O Come Emmanuel"
- 3. **Preparing Our Hearts for Christmas** (Rachel/Joe/Anne) 20 min 7:00 - Advent as preparation for the coming of Jesus Christ: past, present & future
 - prepare our homes/lives to celebrate Christmas (refer to icebreaker responses)
 - prepare our hearts in Advent to receive Jesus this Christmas
 - video promoting Advent Confessions
 - use Advent Confessions handout with wreath-based graphical organizer
 - making an Examination of Conscience, steps to confession
 - students make notes on the wreath graphic about their Examination of Conscience responses – bring to church to help them with their Confession!

4. Group transfers to Oueen of Angels Church

- 5. Advent Confessions (Fr. Jason & maybe 3 visitor priests) 45 min 7:30
 - table leader catechists help to monitor behavior and send students to confessions

- students who have gone to Confession or are waiting can pray quietly and/or come to the gathering space in the back for an Advent Saints worksheet which (at the option of the teacher) can become an in-class activity for Track B, an opportunity to practice saint research skills for the Conf. Name reflection

6. Group transfers back to Parish Center
