Hearing the call *Escuchando el llamado*

SPIRITUAL LIFE MINISTRY

On April 25, 1992, at Holy Name Cathedral, I was asked "Dennis Ramos, are you ready and willing?" I responded: "I am" and proceeded to walk to the steps before the Cathedral Altar and joined my other Deacon brothers. That day will always be fresh in my mind, my parents, family and friends were there to see me take the next step in my journey with the Lord.

I am often asked: "What is a Deacon and what do they do?" Simple answer: "To serve." We serve the church community we are assigned to, in the early church the Deacons served the widows and made sure they had food and money.

Today Deacons assist the priest on the altar, share different ministries with the church community, Sacraments, Bible studies, SPRED, St. Vincent de Paul, Deacons go to areas where places have been hit by tornados, and help people re-build their homes and whatever they can do to bring comfort to people.

The Christmas season is still with us, even though the Christmas music has stopped on the radio stations, Christmas trees have been put in the alley, and presents have been returned to the store, or put away.

During the Advent and the Christmas season people have been called to serve in many ways, John the Baptist, Mary, Shepherds, Wise men and disciples. All are called to serve, even with them not knowing what the outcome would be, but with faith they served without questioning.

Hearing the call of the Lord is not something we expect, it's in the quiet moment we are called through prayer, reflecting and letting yourself to be open to the call.

As a person, I didn't know what to expect, I was never a public person, I never imagine standing up and giving homilies, teaching Bible class, reaching out to those who grieve for their loved one. Faith is a five-letter word, you can't smell, touch or hold it in your hand, faith is in your heart. It's through faith we hear the calling of the Lord. Ask yourself what does he want you to do?

At the end of Mass, we hear these words "Go in peace to love and serve the Lord."

Let's open our ears to the calling and serving the Lord.

La fe es una palabra de dos letras, no se puede oler, tocar o sostener en la mano, la fe está en el corazón. Es a través de la fe que escuchamos el llamado del Señor. Pregúntate qué quiere que hagas.

Al final de la Misa, escuchamos estas palabras: "Vayan en paz a amar y servir al Señor".

Abramos nuestros oídos al llamado y a servir al Señor.



