Queen of Apostles Confirmation Preparation 2024-2025

## This session's objectives:

- -- To teach about the structure of the Confirmation Mass by going through procedures for the Laying on of Hands and Anointing with Oil
- -- To introduce Bishop Daniel Turley (and his roles as a bishop) to the candidates
- -- To provide written evidence to the Pastor, Father Jason Malave, in the form of a letter, that each candidate is preparing seriously for Confirmation and will be ready for Bishop Turley to confirm them
- -- To mark the Advent season in prayer and look forward to the celebration of Christmas

## This session's program:

- 1. Name-tag pick-up; turn in early service forms or late Name essays 0-5 min 6:45
- 2. **Opening Prayer** (Rachel/Joe/Anne) 5 min 6:50 responsory for Late Advent & lighting of wreath, to be lit with paper flames: 3 candles
- 3. Icebreaker: Helping Hands (At Tables/In Groups) 5 min 6:55 For what do we use our hands? At each table, write as many uses as you can in 2 (timed) minutes. Share top 3 uses with the large group.
- 4. "Who Am I?" / Bishop Intro (Rachel/Joe/Anne)

20 min 7:00

Power-Point slides on Bishop Turley (see Notes pages for script!)

- play game to **guess identities** of 2 celebrities and the Bishop
- view photo examples of **what a Bishop does**, in general & during Confirmation Mass connect with uses for hands helping, blessing, calling down the Holy Spirit
- final slides explain the Presentation of Candidates by the Pastor & introduce letter-writing
- 5. Candidates Write Letters to the Pastor (at tables or individually) 55-60 min 7:20
  - use green handout for outline of content; write on the looseleaf lined paper or via devices
  - spread out to empty tables/desks to concentrate on writing the letter
  - catechists help candidates stay on task use your time wisely!

    Track B should aim to do at least the first 1-2 paragraphs at the first half of the session
  - letters to be collected at the end of (2<sup>nd</sup> half of) class! see Rachel/Joe/Anne for exceptions
  - be sure to <u>check over letters</u> for spelling, grammar, fluency, legibility, etc. <u>enjoy cookies</u>
- 6. Service Reminders & Closing Prayer (Rachel/Joe/Anne) 10 min 8:20
  - give out more forms, emphasize community orgs that need help & leaf/snow opportunities
  - Prayer Ritual: Christmas reflection in 2-3 parts
    - option to read aloud 2 paragraphs from box @ on p. 1340 in Bible
  - video reflection "He Came" (embedded in slides) Christmas prayer **MERRY CHRISTMAS!**
