Pointing Toward Jesus *Apuntado hacia Jesús*

Have you ever found satisfaction in helping someone who was lost by pointing them in the right direction? You may have helped a newcomer to find the restroom in one of our churches or directed a friend to the person they sought in a crowded room. There are many times in our lives we might perform this small but fulfilling service.

In today's Gospel reading, John the Baptist sees Jesus walking toward him. John takes the opportunity to point Jesus out to his own disciples, testify to the people about who Jesus is, and explain how their two missions align. John says of Jesus, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world." Though Jesus is years away from the moment of his sacrifice on the cross, the truth of Jesus' saving mission has already been revealed to John. John explains, "the reason why I came baptizing with

water was that he [Jesus] might be made known to Israel” and “he is the one who will baptize with the Holy Spirit.”

There are many representations of this scene in religious art. Some show Jesus far-off, some show John surrounded by his own disciples. You can Google search for Images of “John the Baptist pointing to Jesus” to see some examples. I like the one reproduced (on the front page) in the bulletin, in which Jesus and John are shown side-by-side. John the Baptist casually points to Jesus like he is introducing us to a new friend: “You’d like this guy!”

As Catholic Christians, we are called to do as John the Baptist does: to give witness to who Jesus is, to describe our relationship with Jesus and explain what he does in our lives. Our very lives should point to Jesus, but we need to help others know the right direction to move toward. This is an important form of evangelizing that we can all do.

So do not be afraid to give Jesus the credit for what he has done in your own life. The times that quiet prayer, speaking with Jesus and listening to him in return, has consoled you or helped you come to a life-changing decision. The times that Jesus’ teachings have led you to do the right thing, even when it was difficult. The times that Jesus has sent the Holy Spirit to move in our hearts and the hearts of others, bringing mercy, wisdom and courage. The times you may even have received a miracle.

I think of the times when I have called out to Jesus in prayer and felt his presence with me, his voice calming me. I think of the times when I have sacrificed my time or my resources to help others in need; when I do things for them, I am doing them for Jesus. I think of the times when I have been gifted with an inspiration in the middle of Mass, the solution to a challenge I had been turning over in my mind for days. I think of the ways I have been healed. And I know I need to do a better job myself of sharing these stories with others, to point to the One who made them possible.

Como cristianos católicos, estamos llamados a hacer lo que hace Juan el Bautista: dar testimonio de quién es Jesús, describir nuestra relación con él y explicar lo que hace en nuestras vidas. Nuestras vidas deberían apuntar a Jesús, pero necesitamos ayudar a otros a saber la dirección correcta. Esta es una forma importante de evangelización que todos nosotros podemos hacer.

Así que no tenga miedo de darle a Jesús el crédito por lo que Él ha hecho en su propia vida. Las veces que la oración silenciosa, hablando con Jesús y escuchándolo a cambio, le ha consolado o le ha ayudado a tomar una decisión transformadora. Las veces que las enseñanzas de Jesús le han guiado a hacer lo correcto, incluso cuando era difícil. Las veces que Jesús ha enviado al Espíritu Santo para obrar en nuestros corazones y en los corazones de los demás, trayendo misericordia, sabiduría y valentía. Las veces que incluso puedes haber recibido un milagro.

Yo pienso en las veces que he invocado a Jesús en oración y he sentido su presencia conmigo, su voz calmándome. Pienso en las veces que he sacrificado mi tiempo o mis recursos para ayudar a otros necesitados; cuando hago cosas por ellos, las hago por Jesús. Pienso en las veces que he recibido una inspiración en medio de la Misa, la solución a un desafío que llevaba días dándole vueltas. Pienso en las maneras en que he sido sanado. Y sé que necesito hacer un mejor trabajo para compartir estas historias con otros, para señalar a Quien las hizo posibles.
