FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT

Food for Our Journey *Comida para nuestro viaje*

This weekend, parish children preparing for First Communion are welcomed and recognized in the Rite of Enrollment. In the Rite, the children renew their Baptism promises, formalize their preparation for the sacrament, receive a blessing and prayer aids, and feel the support of their parents and the parish community. Celebrating the Rite of Enrollment also points to several important truths:

The Eucharist is spiritual food that strengthens us against sin. Our First and Second Readings today recall the forbidden fruit eaten by Adam and Eve. In today's Gospel, the very first attempt the devil makes to tempt Jesus is through food, in the midst of his desert fast of forty days and forty nights. Even when we aren't fasting and we do eat several meals and snacks in a day, we are hungry again for this earthly food in a few hours. But the spiritual food of the Eucharist, though a smaller morsel, may last us much longer. Maybe it would help you grow spiritually this Lent to receive the Eucharist daily or to spend more time with Jesus in Eucharistic Adoration.

Este fin de semana, los niños de la parroquia que se preparan para la Primera Comunión son recibidos y reconocidos en el Rito de Inscripción. En este Rito, los niños renuevan sus promesas bautismales, formalizan su preparación para el sacramento, reciben una bendición y herramientas de oración, y sienten el apoyo de sus padres y de la comunidad parroquial. Celebrar el Rito de Inscripción también nos recuerda varias verdades importantes:

La Eucaristía es alimento espiritual que nos fortalece contra el pecado. La Primera Lectura y Segunda Lectura de hoy recuerdan el fruto prohibido que comieron Adán y Eva. En el Evangelio de hoy, el primer intento del diablo por tentar a Jesús es a través de la comida, en medio de su ayuno en el desierto de cuarenta días y cuarenta noches. Incluso cuando no estamos ayunando y comemos varias comidas y botanas al día, volvemos a sentir hambre de este alimento terrenal en pocas horas. Pero el alimento

First Communion is most meaningful when there is full and frequent participation in Mass.

Our catechists encourage children and their families to go to Sunday Mass regularly, but the reality is that very few do. You can help our families feel welcome at Mass by inviting friends with children to attend Mass with you; by greeting and affirming parish families when they do bring their children to Mass; and by serving in parish ministries which help children to participate more meaningfully in Mass such as the Children's Liturgy of the Word. As I say frequently at this time of year, a First Communion is only in fact a First Communion if it is at some point followed by a Second Communion.

Over the next few months, our future First Communicants will be studying the meaning and parts of the Mass and the ways in which the Church is the Body of Christ. **What better way to begin this study than to attend Mass together and pray with the community!** In the Rite of Enrollment, the children receive illustrated books with the full text of the Mass so they can begin to follow along with the prayers of the worshipping community. They receive Rosaries so they can learn to pray to Our Mother Mary, Queen of Apostles, and ask for her prayers.

As a parish community, we share responsibility for the sacramental formation of our children. Thank you for praying with and for these children, and affirming them with your applause, at the Rite of Enrollment this weekend. A tree has been placed in each of our parish churches, hung with ornaments and prayer cards bearing the names of our First Communion candidates. All are invited to take a prayer card home and pray regularly by name for one of these children until their First Communion in early May. Thank you for your help in welcoming our young ones to the table of the Lord!

espiritual de la Eucaristía, aunque sea un bocado más pequeño, puede durar mucho más. Tal vez usted ayudaría a crecer espiritualmente en esta Cuaresma recibir la Eucaristía diariamente o pasar más tiempo con Jesús en la Adoración Eucarística.

La Primera Comunión cobra mayor significado cuando hay la participación plena y frecuente en la Misa. Nuestros catequistas animan a los niños y a sus familias a asistir a la Misa dominical con regularidad, pero la realidad es que muy pocos lo hacen. Pueden ayudar a nuestras familias a sentirse bienvenidas en la Misa invitando a amigos con niños a asistir con ustedes; saludando y animando a las familias de la parroquia cuando traen a sus hijos a Misa; y participando en ministerios parroquiales que ayudan a los niños a participar de forma más significativa en la Misa, como la Liturgia de la Palabra para Niños. Como digo con frecuencia en esta temporada del año, una Primera Comunión solo es realmente una Primera Comunión si va seguida de una Segunda Comunión.

Durante los próximos meses, nuestros futuros alumnos de Primera Comunión estudiarán el significado y las partes de la Misa, y cómo la Iglesia es el Cuerpo de Cristo. **¡Qué bonita manera de comenzar este estudio, asistiendo a Misa juntos y orando con la comunidad!** En el Rito de Inscripción, los niños reciben libros ilustrados con el texto completo de la Misa para que puedan comenzar a seguir las oraciones de la comunidad. Reciben rosarios para que aprendan a rezar a Nuestra Madre María, Reina de los Apóstoles, y a pedirle sus oraciones.

Como comunidad parroquial, compartimos la responsabilidad de la formación sacramental de nuestros niños. Gracias por orar con y por estos niños, y por apoyarlos con sus aplausos durante el Rito de Inscripción este fin de semana. Se ha colocado un árbol en cada una de nuestras iglesias, con adornos y tarjetas de oración con los nombres de nuestros candidatos para la Primera Comunión. Todos están invitados a llevarse una tarjeta a casa y orar regularmente por nombre por uno de estos niños hasta su Primera Comunión a principios de mayo. ¡Gracias por su ayuda para dar la bienvenida a nuestros pequeños a la Cena del Señor!






2026 Annual Catholic Appeal

That journey led me to the apostle Peter—the perfect example of an imperfect man. Peter the Rock is my portrayal of someone we can all relate to.




