Small Faith Groups

All are welcome to be a part of one of ten small faith groups that are being piloted this summer. Ten families are opening up their homes to six other parishioners, to reflect on scripture and share stories about life and faith. It is not scripture study, but rather parishioners walking together in faith. There will be five sessions of ninety minutes each. By following a specific lesson each week, each participant can share at their comfort level around scripture, gifts of our faith, and living out our faith for the week. Approximate locations, days of the week and times are listed. All over eighteen are welcome and you are encouraged to sign up for two available slots. Once assigned, your small faith group leader will contact you with the address. Welcome to small faith groups that the earliest followers of Jesus.
