ATTENDANCE POLICY and FURTHER NOTES ON THE SCHEDULE

CANDIDATES for Confirmation should attend all classes and retreats as listed on their schedule. **Not participating regularly in Confirmation Prep will result in not being adequately prepared to receive the sacrament of Confirmation.** Excessive absences may be a sign that the Candidate is not able to commit to the preparation process at this time, which may delay their Confirmation.

- **Absences** from class or other events due to illness or conflict should be documented with a note, email, phone call, text message to Ms. Rachel Hohner, rhohner@qofachicago.org or **312-857-6782**. Please also contact Ms. Hohner to discuss any ongoing attendance issue or conflict.
- If the Candidate misses either **RETREAT I** or **RETREAT II**, scheduled for November 3, 2026 and February 5, 2026, the Candidate should make up the absence with an alternative retreat or experience.
 - **Retreat I Alternative:** Alternatives for Retreat I may be identified later on.
 - **Retreat II Alternative:** Make-up packet and participation in parish confessions on a Saturday morning in February, March or April, 9am-9:30am at Queen of Angels Church.
- One **PARENT** or **GUARDIAN** should attend with the Candidate on September 21, 2026 and November 9, 2026, and should join the Candidate for the second half of Retreat II on February 5, 2027. *If a parent or guardian is unable to attend, a **Sponsor or another responsible adult relative** should accompany the Candidate.*
- The **SPONSOR(S)** should attend with the Candidate on November 9, 2026 and April 7, 2027, and should join the Candidate for the second half of Retreat II on February 5, 2027. *If the Sponsor is unable to attend, a **parent/guardian or another responsible adult relative** should accompany the Candidate.*
- The Candidate will need to sign up for an **INTERVIEW** with a parish staff member outside of class time during February or March. Appointments will be available after school, on weeknight evenings and on Saturday mornings.
- The **SPONSOR** must be present for the Confirmation Mass on April 10, 2027 or a non-parent proxy will need to be chosen. Parents and Candidates should make sure that family, loved ones and friends are invited to share in this special day.

ASISTENCIA y MÁS INFORMACIÓN SOBRE EL CALENDARIO

Los **CANDIDATOS** para Confirmación deben de asistir a todas las clases y retiros que figuran en su calendario. **No participar regularmente en la Preparación para la Confirmación resultará en no estar adecuadamente preparado para recibir el sacramento de la Confirmación.** Las ausencias excesivas pueden ser una señal de que el Candidato no puede comprometerse con el proceso de preparación en este momento; esto puede retrasar su Confirmación.

- **Las ausencias** de clase u otros eventos debido a enfermedad o conflicto deben documentarse con una nota, mensaje de correo electrónico, llamada o mensaje de texto a la Srta. Rachel Hohner al rhohner@qofachicago.org o al **312-857-6782**. Comuníquese también con la Srta. Hohner para discutir cualquier problema o conflictos frecuentes de asistencia.
- Si el Candidato se falta **RETIRO I** o **RETIRO II**, 3 de noviembre de 2026 y el 5 de febrero de 2027, el Candidato debe completar una experiencia alternativa.
 - **Alternativa al Retiro I:** Es posible que más adelante se identifiquen alternativas para el Retiro I.
 - **Alternativa al Retiro II:** Paquete de hojas con preguntas y participación en confesiones parroquiales un sábado por la mañana en febrero, marzo o abril, de 9am-9:30am en la Iglesia Reina de los Ángeles.
- Un **PADRE** o **TUTOR** deberá de asistir junto con el Candidato el 21 de septiembre del 2026 y 9 de noviembre de 2026, y debe unirse al Candidato para la segunda mitad del Retiro II el 5 de febrero de 2027. *Si por alguna razón el padre/guardián no puede asistir, un **padrino/madrina u otro pariente responsable** deberá acompañar al Candidato.*
- El **PADRINO** o **MADRINA** deberá de asistir junto con el Candidato el 9 de noviembre del 2026 y el 7 de abril de 2027, y debe unirse al Candidato para la segunda mitad del Retiro II el 5 de febrero de 2027. *Si por alguna razón el Padrino o Madrina no puede asistir con el Candidato en estas fechas, un **padre/tutor u otro pariente responsable** deberá acompañar al Candidato.*
- El Candidato deberá inscribirse para una **ENTREVISTA** con un miembro del personal parroquial fuera del horario de clases durante febrero o marzo. Las citas estarán disponibles durante la semana por las tardes y los sábados por la mañana.
- El **PADRINO** o **MADRINA** debe estar presente el día de la Misa de Confirmación que será el 10 de abril de 2027, o se necesita elegir un(a) representante. Los papás/tutores y candidatos deben de asegurarse que toda la familia, seres queridos y amigos estén invitados a celebrar este día tan especial.
